

**Village Of Castalia
December 16, 2025
Meeting Minutes**

The Village of Castalia Council met in Regular Session on December 16 2025 at 7:00 p.m. at the Village of Castalia Hall located at 126 Main Street, Castalia, Ohio. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jim Johnson with the following in attendance: Barb Weyer, Si Nicholson, Cindy Crawford, Jake Smith, and Georgia Artrip was absent. Fiscal Officer Kathy Niehm was in attendance.

Mr. Nicholson Made a Motion to Excuse Georgia Artrip. Mr. Smith seconded the motion. Roll Call: Yeas, unanimous.

Mr. Smith Made a Motion to Approve the 12/9/2025 Minutes. Mrs. Weyer seconded the motion. Roll Call: Yeas, unanimous.

Mr. Nicholson Made a Motion to Approve the Finance Report Dated 12/11/2025. Mrs. Crawford seconded the motion. Roll Call: Yeas, unanimous. Motion carried.

Mrs. Crawford Made a Motion to Approve the Warrants Dated 12/9/2025-12/11/2025. Mr. Nicholson seconded the motion. Roll Call: Yeas, unanimous. Motion carried.

Mrs. Weyer Made a Motion to Accept the Receipts Dated 12/8/2025-12/12/2025. Mr. Nicholson seconded the motion. Roll Call: Yeas, unanimous. Motion carried.

Mrs. Weyer stated she spoke with Fiscal Consultant Diane Schaefer and she stated Brad Zura will no longer be our contact for the audit. Justine will be doing our review.

Zoning Inspector Tom Johnson stated the door trim is in for the Cement Street building and he will be installing it. Mr. Johnson stated he has the yearly report done and will present it to Council.

There was a lengthy discussion on the large water main break that occurred last evening on South Washington street and St. Rt. 101 when a large over load semi could not make the turn and damaged several properties. The Sheriff office and the Erie County Water Department was contacted. The Flock cameras in the Village were able to photograph the license plate of the vehicle. The vehicle was cited and the owners will be libel for all damages.

Mayor Johnson stated there will be more information regarding the storm sewers on Depot Street at the January Council meeting.


Mayor Johnson distributed to Council his list of 2025 Year in Review and 2026 Goals.


