

Village of Castalia
Meeting Minutes-Emergency Meeting
July 30, 2024


The Village of Castalia Council met in Emergency Session on July 30, 2024 at 7:22 p.m. at the Village of Castalia Hall located at 126 Main Street, Castalia, Ohio. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jim Johnson with the following in attendance: Cindy Crawford, Si Nicholson, Jake Smith, Georgia Artrip, Barb Weyer, and Fiscal Officer Kathy Niehm.

Mr. Smith made a Motion to Repeal Resolution #2024-7, A Resolution declaring the intent to proceed with election on the question of the renewal of a tax levy in excess of the 10-mill limitation for providing for current expenses as authorized by section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code; and certifying the same to the Board of Elections of Erie County, Ohio. Mrs. Artrip seconded the motion. Roll Call: Mr. Smith, yes; Mrs. Artrip, yes; Mrs. Crawford, Yes; Mrs. Weyer, yes; Mr. Nicholson, yes. Motion Carried. (The reason for repealing the resolution #2024-7 was the Village attorney had the wrong date for the collection of the taxes.)


Mr. Smith made a Motion to Approve Ordinance #2024-8 a Resolution Repealing and Replacing Resolution #2024-7 Declaring the intent to proceed with election on the question of the renewal of a tax levy in excess of the 10-mill limitation for providing for current expenses as authorized by Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code; and certifying the same to the Board of Elections of Erie County, Ohio. Fiscal Officer Kathy Niehm will prepare the document for the Board of elections and Mayor Johnson will take it to the Board of Elections.

Mr. Smith made a Motion to Approve Ordinance #2024-9, An ordinance providing for election on Amendment to Article 12, Section 12.01(A) of the Castalia Village Charter, relative to bidding requirements for municipal contracts and declaring an emergency. Mrs. Crawford seconded the motion. Roll Call: Mr. Smith, yes; Mrs. Crawford, yes; Mrs. Weyer, yes; Mrs. Artrip, yes; Mr. Nicholson, yes. Motion carried. Fiscal Officer Kathy Niehm will prepare the document for the Board of Elections and Mayor Johnson will take it to the Board of Elections.

With no further business to come before the Council; Mrs. Weyer made a Motion to Adjourn. Mr. Nicholson seconded the motion. Roll Call: Yeas, unanimous. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:26 p.m.
