

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-8

A RESOLUTION REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NUMBER 2024-7 DECLARING THE INTENT TO PROCEED WITH ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF A TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION FOR PROVIDING FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 5705.19(A) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND CERTIFYING THE SAME TO THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS OF ERIE COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2024, the Council of the Village of Castalia adopted a resolution (the "Resolution of Necessity") pursuant to R.C. 5705.03, declaring the necessity for the purpose of providing for current expenses within the Village of Castalia to levy the renewal of a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation in the amount of 4.66 mills, for a period of five (5) years. The Resolution of Necessity also included a request to the Erie County Auditor to provide it with a Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue relative to the aforementioned tax; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2024-7 as previously adopted, contained a scrivener's error relative to the commencement date and the levy due date; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to repeal and replace Resolution Number 2024-7 with the within resolution; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTALIA, ERIE COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Castalia has received the Auditor's Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue of the entire territory of the Village of Castalia, Erie County, Ohio and now desires to proceed with the submission of the question of the renewal of an existing levy for the purpose of providing for current expenses, pursuant to *section 5705.19(A) of the Revised Code*, to the electors of the Village.

SECTION 2. The question of the of the renewal of the aforementioned tax levy shall be submitted to the electors in the entire territory of the Village of Castalia at the general election to be held therein on November 5, 2024 (the "Election Date"). All of the territory of the Village of Castalia is located within Erie County, Ohio.

SECTION 3. That the form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows:

**PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL)
VILLAGE OF CASTALIA, ERIE COUNTY, OHIO
(A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage)**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of Castalia, Erie County, Ohio, for the purpose of providing for current expenses; that the county auditor estimates will collect \$75,000.00 annually, at a rate not exceeding 4.660 mills for each \$1.00 of taxable value, which amounts to \$137.00 for each \$100,000.00 of the county auditor's appraised value, for a period of 5 years, commencing in 2024, and first due in calendar year 2025.

SECTION 4. The Fiscal Officer of the Council is hereby authorized and directed to certify, not later than August 7, 2024 (which date is not less than 90 days prior to the Election Date), to the Erie County Board of Elections a certified copy of the Resolution of Necessity as previously adopted by the Council, a certified copy of this Resolution, and a copy of the Erie County Auditor's Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue.

SECTION 5. The Fiscal Officer of the Council is also hereby directed and authorized to certify to the Erie County Board of Elections that the renewal of the within tax levy will be for current expenses of the village, for a period of five (5) years, and that the levy will be placed upon the tax list and duplicate for the 2024 tax year (commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025) if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

SECTION 6. The Council hereby declares that Resolution Number 2024-7, as adopted on June 11, 2024, is hereby repealed and replaced with the within resolution.


