

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-2

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT TO PROCEED WITH ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF AN ADDITIONAL TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CASTALIA PURSUANT TO R.C. 5705.19(G).

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2021, the Council of the Village of Castalia adopted an ordinance (hereinafter the "Ordinance of Necessity") declaring the necessity to levy an additional tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation to generate the sum of \$50,000.00 each year of the levy for a period of five years for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council has received the Auditors certification of the current tax valuation of the entire territory of the Village of Castalia and the number of mills required to generate \$50,000.00 in revenue per year by such additional tax, and now desires to proceed with the submission of the question of levying the additional tax levy to the electors of the entire Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTALIA, STATE OF OHIO, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. The Council of the Village of Castalia now desires to proceed with the submission of the question of an additional tax levy for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges within the Village pursuant to **R.C. 5705.19(G)** to the electors of the entire territory of the Village of Castalia, Ohio.

Section 2. The question of such additional tax levy shall be submitted to the electors in the entire territory of the Village at the election to be held therein on May 3, 2022 (the "Election Date"). The territory of the Village of Castalia is located entirely within Erie County, Ohio.

Section 3. The form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows:

A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage

An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of Castalia for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges, at a rate not exceeding 2.75 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.275 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five years, commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.



Section 4. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to certify, not later than February 2, 2022 (which date is not less than 90 days prior to the Election Date), to the Erie County Board of Elections a copy of the Resolution of Necessity and a copy of this resolution together with the Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Millage Rate Required to Produce a Specific Amount of Revenue setting forth

the number of mills required to generate \$50,000.00 by the approval of the within additional tax levy during the first year of collection, based on the current tax valuation of the Village, as estimated by the Erie County Auditor.

Section 5. The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed and shall certify to the Erie County Board of Elections that the within additional tax levy will be for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges within the Village of Castalia, for a period of five years, and that the levy, will be placed upon the tax list and duplicate for the 2022 tax year (commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023) if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Section 6. All formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
